EIDT and ADDT Providers,

We appreciate your patience over the past several days as we looked for ways to increase members' access to care and to help you continue to provide quality services to our members during this unprecedented time.

Empower is committed to enabling members to reduce exposure to and transmission of COVID-19, and to preserve our network's capacity for the duration of this public health emergency consistent with Arkansas Division of Medical Services (DMS) mandates.

Effective April 3, 2020, Empower will be following the DMS guidelines regarding EIDT/ADDT Nurses' providing services outside of a clinic setting during the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency. We will notify you via provider alert once configuration is complete and you can bill Empower for these services.
